Rich layers of currant and cherry fruit, framed by nicely integrated oak.

2017 MOSCATO, CALIFORNIA

Sweet and refreshing, with aromas of white peach and apricot. Flavors of summer fruit accented by hints of honey and citrus.

Yellow straw color. Aromas of honeysuckle, wrapped Botan rice candy, dried pineapples, and ripe apricots in syrup with a round, crisp, very sweet light-to-medium body and a smooth, breezy sweet almonds and fruit cocktail finish with no oak. A very sweet and lovable moscato.

Sweet and lively, with floral aromas of rose petals, peach and apricot. Flavors of ripe summer fruit and rose petals are accented by hints of currant.
